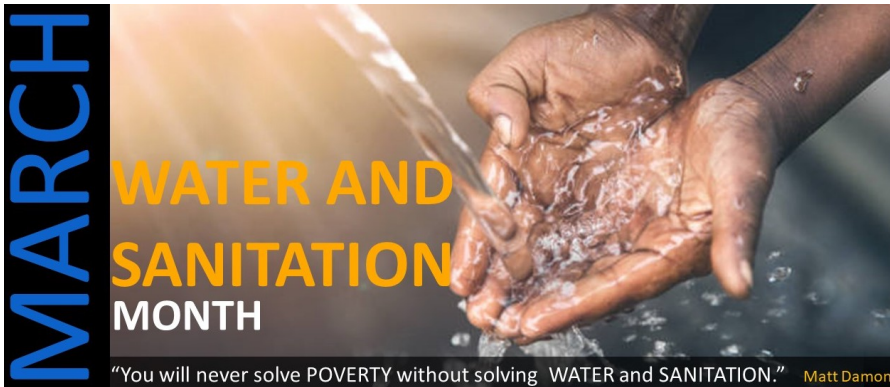


March is Water and Sanitation Month
