## Dues Increasing July 1

Quarterly dues will increase in the new fiscal year that begins July 1. Dues will increase from \$185 to \$235, not including \$25 quarterly optional donations to the Rotary Foundation and GRSP that are encouraged.

### Why now?

- Our dues have not increased since 2015.
- Both District 6900 and Rotary International have increased dues three times since 2015.
- The adjustment also accounts for increasing prices for meals, venue costs, and other routine expenses that support our meetings and activities.

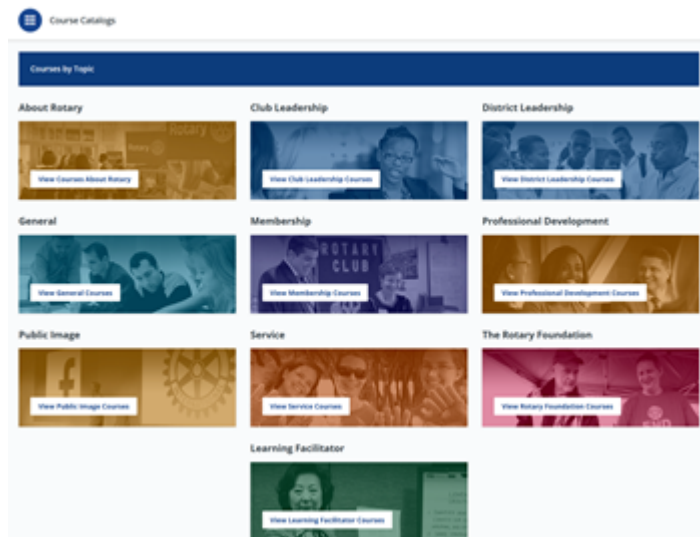
