Please bring coats, blankets, or cash donations to tomorrow's meeting, drop your donations off at Brigit Smallridge's office or send money to Brigit. Cash donations will help the organization buy coats and blankets at discounted prices. Even a \$5 or \$10 donation can buy a coat or blanket.

Rotary has supported the Coat Closet almost since the launch of the Thomas County Food Bank 20-plus years ago. The Coat Closet is open from mid-October through early December during regular food bank hours. Volunteers schedule Food Bank clients to "shop" for coats for their families. Children are offered coats annually and adults can get them every two years. Blankets are distributed as needed. All clients meet income and circumstance qualifications for food assistance.

Typically, the coat closet provides more than 1,000 coats and several hundred blankets every year.
